### COURSE OVERVIEW

This five-day intensive course enables participants to develop the necessary expertise to audit a Business Continuity Management System (BCMS) and to manage a team of auditors by applying widely recognized audit principles, procedures and techniques. During this training, the participant will acquire the necessary knowledge and skills to proficiently plan and perform internal and external audits in compliance with ISO 19011 the certification process according to 17021. Based on practical exercises, the participant will develop the skills (mastering audit techniques) and competencies (managing audit teams and audit program, communicating with customers, conflict resolution, etc.) necessary to efficiently conduct an audit. This training is compatible with BS 25999 audit (Business continuity management specification) and ISO 27031 (Guidelines for information and communication technology readiness for business continuity).

### COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the end of this course, you will be able to :

- ✓To acquire the expertise to perform an ISO 22301 internal audit following ISO 19011 guidelines
- ✓To acquire the expertise to perform an ISO 22301 certification audit following ISO 19011 guidelines and the specifications of ISO 17021
- ✓To acquire the expertise necessary to manage a BCMS audit team
- ✓Understanding the operation of the BCMS in accordance with ISO22301 or ISO 27031
- ✓To understand the relationship between a BCMS, including risk management, controls and compliance with the requirements of different stakeholders of the organization
- ✓To improve the ability to analyze the internal and external environment of an organization, risk assessment and audit decision-making in the context of a BCMS

### COURSE AUDIENCE

This certification course is designed and suited for internal auditors, auditors wanting to perform and lead BCMS certification audits, project managers or consultants wanting to master the BCMS audit process, persons responsible for the Business Continuity conformity in an organization, members of a business continuity team, expert advisors in information technology and technical experts wanting to prepare for an Business continuity audit function.

### PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION

Upon successful completion of the “PECB Certified ISO 22301 Lead Auditor” exam and the accumulation of the required years of experience and hours of audit activities, participants will be qualified as a **PECB ISO 22301 Auditor / Lead Auditor**.

### PRE-REQUISITE

Participants are expected to have taken BCM Manager course, the CBCI Certification Training course, or possess basic knowledge of ISO 22301, BS 25999 or ISO 27031 and business continuity concepts is recommended.

## EXAMINATION

The “PECB Certified ISO 22301 Lead Auditor” exam fully meets the requirements of the PECB Examination and Certification Program (ECP). This is a 3-hour long exam and will cover the competence domains covered in the course outline.

## CERTIFICATION

After successfully completing the exam, a certificate will be issued to participants who successfully passed the exam. Successful participants can go on to apply for the credentials of PECB Certified ISO 22301 Auditor or PECB Certified ISO 22301 Lead Auditor depending on their level of experience.

To qualify as a PECB ISO 22301 Auditor, applicants are required to have 2 years of professional experience (with at least 1 year of Business Continuity work experience), audit activities totaling 200 hours and to sign the PECB code of ethics.

To qualify as a PECB ISO 22301 Lead Auditor, applicants are required to have 5 years of professional experience (with at least 1 year of Business Continuity work experience), audit activities totaling 300 hours and to sign the PECB code of ethics.

## AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARDS INSTITUTE (ANSI)



The standard used by ANSI to accredit certification bodies is an American National Standard as well as an ISO Standard-ANSI/ISO/IEC 17024. Accreditation to an international standard is extremely important for certification bodies that have global operations or aspirations. Currently, ANSI chairs the ISO/IEC 17024 Workgroup and is actively working with other member countries in implementing a Multilateral Agreement on accredited certification programs.
