7 years after the launch of the first edition of ISO22301 in May 2012, the ISO committee has released the second version of ISO22301 in October 2019. In this 1-day workshop, we discuss the changes in the new ISO22301:2019 and what new requirements should a BCM manager take note of when planning the programme and when preparing for the ISO22301:2019 certification. Also, get to know the challenges of transitioning to the revised standards.

This is especially useful for BCM team members who will be starting the process of a certification or re-certification audit to the new standards.
